

## **Capital Improvements:**

Your contributions to our parish help maintain the facility, making it the center of prayer in our community. Over the past year, a significant upgrade was undertaken to improve the quality of the outdoor lighting with the installation of LED lighting throughout the church property and parking lots. The upper and lower church parking lots were resealed and repainted. We were also able to install a new LED lighting system along the main hallway of the second floor of Saint Joseph as well as in both restrooms for the area used primarily for the purposes of religious education for the youth of both parishes.
