

Tuesday of this week, August 15th, is the FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION and it is a HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION. All Catholics are obliged to participate in the celebration of Mass on this day as we commemorate two great events: the departure of Mary from this life and the assumption of her body into heaven. The Church's official teaching of the Assumption says that at the end of her life on earth, Mary was assumed body and soul into Heaven. Some mistakenly believe that Mary "ascended" into Heaven but it was Jesus Christ who ascended into Heaven by His own power. Mary was "assumed" or taken up to Heaven by God. Pope Pius XII, in 1950, infallibly proclaimed that Mary, "after the completion of her earthly life was assumed body and soul into the glory of Heaven." Because Mary was conceived without original sin, the consequence of that sin being death, Mary's body was not allowed to corrupt nor was it allowed to remain in a tomb. Many cities claim the mortal remains of saints, both famous and those little known, but there are no records of Mary's bodily remains being venerated anywhere in the world.

Mary is truly our model of faith, challenging us to trust in God's will to spend ourselves in the service of God and others and to embrace and accept the challenge and mystery of life.
